Please note, the Classic ACCUPLACER test will be retired in January of 2019. We will accept Classic ACCUPLACER scores until January 2021. PCC will begin administering the Next-Generation ACCUPLACER test in October 2018. COMPASS scores will no longer be used for placement.

Completing a prerequisite course with a grade of C or better qualifies the student to advance to the next higher course. Successful course completion supersedes the need for the ACT or ACCUPLACER
