This is a transfer program that enables a student to complete a degree and transfer to a four-year university to complete a Bachelor of Science Degree in Accounting, Business Administration, or other business related field. The Pratt Community College curriculum consists of a general education core with specific courses in business, accounting, economics and computers.

Accountants are employed in public accounting, industry, government, and nonprofit organizations. They measure, report, and process financial information necessary for decision making in these areas. The job opportunities are varied for a person with a degree in business administration and may include such areas as finance, management, marketing or sales.



Associate in Applied Science:

- Business Administration
- Administrative Assistant

These degrees are designed for the student who wants to attend college for two years to obtain job skills and then go to work. We help students find jobs while they are at PCC, and we help them find jobs upon graduation.

Students in the AAS degree are not required to take College Algebra, Speech, and some of the other general education courses.

These degrees are not intended for a student wishing to transfer to the four-year school, but some students do transfer by picking up the necessary general education courses after obtaining their degree. This allows the student to have job skills for a position while finishing their four-year degree.

There are also one-year certificate programs available in Business Administration and Administrative Assistant.
