



FALL 2019 ELECTRICAL POWER TECHNOLOGY- Application Checklist

- *Application Period: September 1, 2018 March 15, 2019
- *PCC General Admission Application is REQUIRED PRIOR to submitting EPT Application
- * Application packet will be provided during campus tour
 - 1) Application -
 - Incomplete application packets will NOT be accepted
 - 2) Official Transcripts
 - Official transcripts from High School/GED and ALL colleges attended are required.
 - Submit official copies of your high school transcript or GED certificate (if applicable) and transcripts from any college previously attended to the Office of Admissions/Registrar
 - Pratt Community College can receive official transcripts electronically from the following services:
 - Parchment
 - National Transcript Center
 - National Student Clearinghouse
 - e-Scrip Safe
 - If you have taken PCC classes (on campus or online) transcripts do not have to be sent
 - Order requests or statement verifying sent electronically or via mail must be included in "application packet"
 - 3) Driving Record -
 - Copy of current driver's license
 - Copy of driving record search: https://www.accesskansas.org/ssrv-mvr-ltd/
 - Your driving record must not contain a history of DUI
 - 4) References-
 - Complete the cover sheet and return with your application packet
 - Provide the Reference Performance Appraisal to 2 references (to be returned directly to PCC)
 - 5) Health Physical
 - 6) Student Insurance Verification/Waiver
 - 7) ACCUPLACER or ACT Test Scores
 - If math and reading requirements have not been confirmed through transcripts and/or testing was completed at a location other than PCC

SELECTION CRITERIA OVERVIEW:

Selection Criteria is performance outcome based. The selection criterion consists of:

- 1) GPA requirements: (4.0 = 40 points)
 Overall GPA requirement is 2.5 or higher.
- 2) References (100% = 80 points)
 - Each reference performance appraisal has the possibility of earning 40 points
- 3) Campus Visit/Interview (100% = 100 points)

 Based on interview rubric (measuring attitude, professionalism, interactions with staff, etc.)
