At Pratt Community College, we have a policy that any student with existing cumulative loans of \$30,000 or more must complete an appeal in order to see if they qualify for further loans at PCC. This policy is in place to help the students at PCC be as successful as they can be while still being able to manage their finances. According to the National Student Loan Data System, you have a total loan amount that exceeds \$30,000.

If you wish to pursue further loans at Pratt Community College, you must provide the following documentation.

1). Personal Letter of Appeal

- a. How much you want to borrow per semester to complete your program
- b. Your expected date of graduation and what program you are pursuing
- c. Any special circumstances that have caused your excess of loans

2). Make sure all official college transcripts are on file in the Admissions office.

Once all documentation is received, the Vice President of Finance and Operations will review your appeal. Please allow up to 14 days for a response.
