- **ATI TEAS®** The ATI TEAS® is the entrance exam for the Nursing Program at Pratt Community College. The exam must be scheduled and completed in a timely manner to ensure that scores are available PRIOR to the application deadline, and can be included in the "application packet".

  - Minimum scores required:
    - OVERALL Adjusted Individual 58.7%
    - SCIENCE 50%
    - READING 65%
  - o Applicant must take all sections to obtain an "Overall Score". Individual sections may be "retaken" to raise Science or Reading scores.
- OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS are required. Send the transcripts when possible utilizing electronic transcript services (not fax).

Hard copy transcripts must be addressed to: Pratt Community College, Registrar, 348 NE SR 61, Pratt, KS 67124. Please place a statement in your application packet that the transcript was sent by mail.

- Official High School transcript
  - If electronic transcript service orders are placed a copy of the "order request" must be included in the application packet
  - o Or Official GED or Home School transcript sent to PCC
- Official College transcript(s)
  - o Must submit Official transcripts from ALL colleges attended
  - If electronic transcript service orders are placed a copy of the "order request" must be included in the application packet
    - If you have had transcripts sent within the past 3 years, new transcripts do not have to be sent, unless the transcript has "In Process" courses included
    - If you have taken classes through PCC (on campus or online) transcripts do not have to be sent
- Students with an F-1 VISA must meet all "International Student Requirements" as identified <a href="http://prattcc.edu/student-services/international">http://prattcc.edu/student-services/international</a>
  - TOEFL scores of: Writing 15 Speaking 15 Reading 16 Listening 15
  - Required for all students residing in a non-English speaking country
  - o TOEFL scores must be included in the "Application Packet
- Fill out the FAFSA Submit the FAFSA as early as possible. If you have completed 96 hours or more an appeal must be completed. Contact the financial aid office at: <a href="mailto:finaid@prattcc.edu">finaid@prattcc.edu</a> or 620-450-2169
- **EMAIL ADDRESS:** Applicants must provide, use and monitor a valid email account. Failure to respond to notices and / or requests in a timely manner may result in the application processing / consideration being terminated. PCC staff will provide a clear time requirement for each item requested. PCC staff will send one reminder of items that are incomplete. PCC Nursing Admissions will terminate consideration of application for repeated failures of the prospective student to read emails, follow instructions, and respond in a timely manner, and meet stated deadlines.
