CLINICAL & On Campus REQUIREMENTS:

- ALL clinical settings are in the Central Kansas area.
- ALL clinical schedules **require** **WEEKLY** (every week September through April) onsite, in Kansas required. We expect you to always be safe, and request that you make the necessary adjustment to drive time to allow for bad weather.
- All clinical sites are contracted & supervised by PCC in accordance with KSBN. There is **NOT** the option selecting a area hospital and arranging a preceptor setting.
- ALL students, including ADN Hybrid/Online students are required to be in Central Kansas for scheduled clinical and simulation lab (simulation lab is in Pratt) assignments.
- ALL students **are assigned** to the clinical location at which they will receive clinical supervision and experience.
- Clinical schedule and Calendar will be provided during the Mandatory Orientation experience in June each year.
- CPR CERTIFICATION: American Heart Association “Health Care Provider” CPR or American Red Cross “Professional Rescuer” CPR. Alternatives are NOT accepted
- *PLEASE NOTE..... There ARE other days that online students are required to be on campus. Specifically at the start and end of EACH semester. The calendar provided at orientation will identify those days as best as can be determined. **Your scheduling must make allowances for such occurrences.***
- ***SCHEDULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE... ACCOMODATIONS MAY NEED TO BE MADE.***
- ***PCC and Clinical Sites will coordinate and make every possible attempt to ensure as consistent days / hours as possible.***
