PCC is located in one of the prime hunting and fishing areas of Kansas. The region is well recognized for its excellent deer, pheasant, turkey and waterfowl hunting. Pratt is the home to the headquarters of the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism. Many KDWPT professionals live in the Pratt area and serve as an outstanding resource of high quality instruction for the WOO program
