ENGLISH AND MATH COURSE PLACEMENT

The administration approves the use of the Kansas Board of Regents systemwide English and math multiple placement measures to assess student readiness for college-level English and math courses. Utilizing multiple measures to assess student readiness assures students who need additional support are placed in the appropriate corequisite courses for their college-level English and/or math courses. Students who place into a corequisite course must enroll in both the corequisite and college-level course simultaneously. Students enrolled in corequisite course(s) may not drop/withdraw from the course(s) unless they also withdraw from the college-level course(s). Placement measures are valid for 5 years from the date of the test/high school GPA.

Placement procedures will be consistent with the philosophy and mission of the college and be endorsed by the Board of Trustees.
