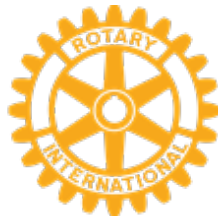

Scholarship Application for Pratt Community College

Scholarship Terms:

- Total award is \$1,000 - \$500 awarded fall semester, \$500 awarded spring semester (if GPA is met)
- Scholarship is paid directly to Pratt Community College for use for tuition, fees, housing, or book expenses.
- Must earn a fall semester 2.5 GPA and be in good academic standing to receive spring scholarship award.
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student (or 12 credit hours per semester) at Pratt Community College.
- Scholarship is non-renewable for more than two semesters and is not transferable.
- Must be a high school graduate or hold the equivalent of a high school degree (GED, etc).
