

COLLEGE START OVERLOAD PETITION

Pratt Community College Concurrent Enrollment (**College Start**) students may not enroll in more than twelve (12) credit hours per semester, or eight credit hours per summer session, unless permission is granted by the Vice President for Instruction. This enrollment restriction has been established to prevent excessive enrollments that do not benefit students.

*Note: Courses that cross semesters are prorated between semesters. I.E., a 3.0 credit hour Literature course starting November 1 and ending March 15 is prorated to 1.5 credit hours for Fall and 1.5 credit hours for Spring. An Overload Petition is not required if the student's semester enrollment exceeds twelve semester credit hours for this reason.
