

Information Network Technology INT Pathway



Information Technology courses allow high school students in 9th (special permission) – 12th grade to begin their college and technical classes. In order to earn an Associate of Applied Science Degree, students must complete 65 credit hours. Please utilize the College Catalog from our website to validate program/degree requirements. Information Network Technology (INT) 3rd party credentials may be earned upon successful completion of select courses outlined below. The college courses followed by "online option" notation may be offered face-to-face and/or online. High school offerings are not available in all areas.

Cost

Secondary students enrolled in a post-secondary tiered technical course at Pratt Community College will not be charged tuition or general fees. Students will be responsible for book and course fees. Course fees may be charged for designated courses.

Secondary students who enroll in courses that are non-tiered will be charged the current tuition and fees as set by Pratt Community College.

Degree / Certification Options

Pratt Community College offers an Associate of Applied Science Degree as well as INT certifications.

Certifications include CompTIA (Computing Technology Industry Association) Certifications in Computer Technology A+, Network + and Security+.
