Encore is the college's premier vocal ensemble. This auditioned group refines musical talent, represents Pratt regionally, delivers dynamic performances, and acquires practical experience through activities such as an annual performance tour.

### KAPPA BETA DELTA (KBD)

Kappa Beta Delta honors high-achieving business students who demonstrate a commitment to excellence. Membership distinguishes students within their field and prepares them for future leadership roles.

## **NOVEL IDEAS – BOOK CLUB**

Founded in 2024, Novel Ideas is committed to cultivating thoughtful readers and engaged thinkers. Members examine themes of identity, culture, and society, collaborating with the Pratt Public Library to broaden their impact beyond campus. Reading choices influence personal and academic engagement.

## **PERFORMING ARTS**

Performing Arts integrates creativity with commitment. Open to all majors, students participate in choir, band, theater, and technical production, developing skills through public performances and community engagement. Opportunities include concerts and outreach initiatives such as the PCC Kids Choir.

## **PHI THETA KAPPA (PTK)**

Phi Theta Kappa recognizes students for academic excellence and encourages further achievement. Members develop leadership skills, participate in research and service, and establish a foundation for continued academic and professional success.

## **RODEO**

Rodeo is grounded in perseverance and tradition. Competing in the Central Plains Region, athletes train in advanced facilities and represent Pratt in a highly demanding collegiate sport.

## **SHOOTING SPORTS**

Shooting Sports fosters discipline, focus, and responsibility among its members. Athletes receive training in safe firearm handling and develop teamwork and leadership skills through competitions and community engagement.

## **STEM CLUB**

STEM Club channels curiosity into practical application. Students lead projects and promote science through community outreach, extending discovery beyond the classroom.

## **THEATER**

Theater at Pratt stages full-scale productions each semester, bringing together students and community members. During the summer, one of the state's largest music theater camps develops emerging performers. Students gain the skills necessary for confident stage presence.

## BASEBALL

Baseball is recognized for consistent performance, earning NJCAA Region VI Tournament placements in 2019, 2022, 2023, and 2024. Upgraded facilities, including a turf field and advanced indoor training spaces, support athlete development.

## CHEERLEADING

Cheerleading is a competitive team of over 20 athletes who perform at home games and achieve recognition at regional and national competitions, contributing significantly to campus events.

## CROSS COUNTRY

Cross Country athletes compete against leading programs throughout the Midwest and nationally, including participation in the NJCAA Cross Country National Championships. The men's team achieved a 20th-place national finish in 2021, demonstrating the program's perseverance and discipline.

## ESPORTS

Esports integrates strategic thinking with competition. Teams compete in NJCAA Esports (NJCAAE) and other events, including LAN tournaments in leading titles such as Valorant and League of Legends. A 20-station gaming facility supports high-level, focused play. This year, PCC captured the program's third NJCAAE national championship, securing back-to-back national titles to close the season.

## MEN'S & WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Men's and Women's Basketball programs consistently compete at a high level, advancing to the NJCAA Region VI Tournament for the past three seasons. Dedicated facilities and a competitive culture prepare athletes for future opportunities.

## MEN'S & WOMEN'S SOCCER

Men's and Women's Soccer programs maintain a standard of competitive success. The men's team won consecutive NJCAA Region VI Championships in 2021 and 2022, while the women's team secured the NJCAA Region IV Championship in 2022. Both teams compete in NJCAA Division II.

## MEN'S & WOMEN'S TENNIS

Men's & Women's Tennis builds disciplined competitors. With a focus on skill, consistency, and match play, student-athletes are prepared to compete and advance to the next level.

## SOFTBALL

Softball demonstrates ongoing progress with consecutive NJCAA Region IV Tournament appearances in 2023 and 2024. Enhanced facilities and a focus on athlete development prepare participants for advancement in competition.

## TRACK & FIELD

Track & Field competes at an advanced level throughout the Midwest and has produced NJCAA All-Americans. The program benefits from a modern track and turf complex and will host the 2024 NJCAA Region IV Track & Field Championships, providing both performance and development opportunities.

## VOLLEYBALL

Volleyball competes with clear objectives and recently qualified for the 2024 NJCAA Region IV Tournament. On-campus facilities support focused training and a collaborative approach to success.

## WRESTLING

Wrestling exemplifies excellence at Pratt, producing 45 NJCAA All-Americans, five national champions, and six national titles. The program is a four-time Jayhawk Conference Champion and 2023 NJCAA National Runner-Up. Athletes collectively contribute over 2,000 hours of service annually.



# PRATT COMMUNITY COLLEGE

## ECONOMIC VALUE OF PRATT COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Pratt Community College (PCC) plays a vital regional role, enrolling 2,129 students and generating 28,609 credit hours annually. PCC expands access through initiatives such as PRATT-ON-LINE, EDUKAN, and affordable pathways, including the Kansas Promise Act. Students benefit from concurrent high school courses, free career and technical education for eligible participants, and programs. PCC drives achievement by providing financial aid, tutoring, and testing. Each year, the institution awards \$186,245 in scholarships to Pratt County residents and secures over \$5.2 million in state and federal grants. Beyond academics, students contributed 9,254 service hours showing strong community engagement. As a regional hub, the campus hosts 200 groups and over 3,000 visitors annually, featuring events such as the Miss Kansas Pageant, Academic Olympics, and athletic competitions. Economically, PCC employs 215 individuals, maintains an annual payroll of nearly \$8.1 million, and spends \$2 million locally, prioritizing local vendors. These efforts establish PCC as a cornerstone for education, workforce development, and community vitality in Pratt County.



PCC is an accredited institution of higher education, having been formally recognized and accredited by a number of agencies.
